



Parent Pledge of Upholding Community Health Standards

At Maayan Torah Day School it is our priority to provide a safe and welcoming environment for all of our families. As we know, *Kol Yisroel Areiveim Zeh LaZeh*, every Jew is responsible for each other, and this is an important part of our community response throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. Now more than ever, each student and family, along with our staff members, will have to make a commitment to our school community to ensure the well-being of our “Maayan” family – both in and out of school by following certain community standards.

Parent Pledge

To ensure good health for myself, families, staff, and students, I, _____, the parent of _____ pledge to uphold the following Maayan community health standards every day, and to educate our children to follow them as well. I commit to these standards starting September 1st, 2020.

- Keep my children home from school if anyone in our household has any signs of primary symptoms of Covid-19. Returning to school will require consultation with a medical professional and school administrator. These symptoms include cough, fever of greater than 100.4°F or chills, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing.
- Keep children home for 72 hours after the fever subsides (without fever reducing medication) and other symptoms of illness improve.
- Keep my children home from school if anyone in our household was exposed to someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 until consulting with a medical professional and school administrator.
- To follow Oregon state guidelines for wearing face coverings which state that children age 5 and up are required to wear a face covering in indoor public places, and outdoors, when physical distancing is not possible. - Be mindful of physical distancing by ensuring 6 feet from others outside of your household
- Adhere to on campus procedures for health & safety (eg. Wearing a mask to carpool, restricting visitors to campus, etc.)
- Comply with directions from health officials for quarantine.
- Reach out to the school administration with any questions.

In this unprecedented time, Maayan is striving to provide a quality educational experience while keeping everyone safe. By following these principles, I will help ensure the safety of our community and demonstrate our Torah values for safeguarding lives.
